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Summary of Proposed Modifications

- 1. Minor edits to MLOs of six modules
- 2. Change the title and MLOs and syllabus of Farm Management Safety and Law (to Farm Safety)
- 3. Replace New Venture Creation BUST07052 5 ECTS with Agricultural Enterprise Diversification 5 ECTS AGFF0711 in Semester 5
- 4. Replace Sustainable Agriculture AGRI07005 5 ECTS with Forest and Woodland Management 5 ECTS AGFF07012 in Semester 5
- 5. Move Market Research from Semester 5 to Semester 6

Rationale for Modifications

The changes to module LOs, revised title, reduced syllabus and replacement of 2 modules are required following extensive engagement with Teagasc concerning approval for the above-mentioned programmes under the Trained Farmer Status (TFS) scheme. LOs were mapped to the TFS requirements (See Appendix 1) and both HoDs, programme chairs, and head of Mountbellew Agricultural College met with Teagasc to review alignment. The revised module LOs, title and syllabus reflect the feedback received from Teagasc and subsequent review with approval.
